Abstract

The aim of this study is to investigate the impact of Arabic as a mother tongue on English pronunciation of 3rd level students at the college of languages- Sudan University of science & Technology. Descriptive and analytical methods have been used as well as a test and a questionnaire. The study sample has been drawn from (20) 3rd level students .As for the questionnaire as many teachers have expressed their opinion on the questionnaire's statements. The study has come up with the following results: English language is complicated because orthography does not reflect the pronunciation. University syllabus does not sufficiently demonstrate pronunciation drills and exercises, not to mention students' lack of basic knowledge of sound system of English phonetics and phonology. The study has recommended that: College of Languages should intervene to introduce the proper remedy for the issue in question. Solve this problem by adding syllabus which covers pronunciation drills and exercises. The student should be aware to the basics knowledge of sound system of English Phonetics and Phonology in contrastive manner. In addition the researcher made some suggestions for further future studies.

المستخلص

هدفت هذه الدراسة لتقصي تأثير اللغة العربية كلغة أم على طلاب المستوى الثالث بكلية اللغات جامعة السودان للعلوم والتكنولوجبا أستخدم المنهج الوصفي التحليلي في جمع المعلومات الخاصة بالبحث كما استخدم ايضا الاختبار والاستبانة أستهدفت عينة الدراسة عشرين طالب من المستوى الثالث. كذالك للاستبانة مجموعة من معلمي اللغة الإنجليزية عبروا عن آرائهم في فرضيات الإستبانة بوصلت الدراسه للنتائج التالية: تعتبر اللغة الانجليزية لغة معقدة لأن التمثيل الكتابي للكلمة لايعكس نطق الكلمة المنهج الجامعي لايمثل بصورة كافية التدريبات والتمارين الخاصه بالنطق في اللغة الإنجليزية, ناهيك عن نقص الطلاب في أساسيات المعرفة الخاصة بالنظام الصوتي وعلم الأصوات في اللغة الإنجليزية. توصلت الدراسة للأتي: على كلية اللغات ان تتدخل لتقديم العلاج المناسب للمسألة المعنية . حل هذه المشكلة وذلك بإضافة مناهج تغطي التمارين والتدريبات الخاصة بالنطق في اللغة الإنجليزية. على الطلاب ان يكونوا على علم باساسيات المعرفة للنظام الصوتي وعلم الأصوات في اللغة الإنجليزية بالأضافة لبعض المقترحات التي قدمهاالباحث لدراسات أكثر في المستقبل.
