Abstract

This study aimed at investigating reading comprehension problems among EFL learners. The case study of second year Klakla Model Secondary School students. The researcher used a test to accept or refute the hypotheses mentioned in chapter one. The researcher also has used the descriptive analytical method to analyze the collected data. The study found out that the EFL learners face many problems such as slow reading, poor background knowledge, lack of vocabulary and lack of reading habits. The researcher recommended that families and teachers should concern building rich background knowledge by encouraging students to read materials full of cultural information. Teachers should choose short text according to students' level and devote enough time for silent reading
