Services, have e Fayette study to describe the status of displaced communities and social effects, which left by displacement.

The study was based on the most important questions whether the displaced people will return to their villages after more than sixteen years of staying in the camp.

The importance of the study lies in the fact that Darfur states are heavily populated and occupy a large geographical area, which represents one-fifth of the area of Sudan after the secession of the south, in addition to addressing the issue of Darfur and the displaced and highlighting it and make it an international issue.

The study followed the descriptive analytical, comparative and statistical approach and used data collection tools from observation of participation, interviews and questionnaire.

I have reached recommendations, the most important of which are: The State shall endeavor to establish security in the areas of origin of the displaced, so that awareness-raising can be attractive, and support the peace process between the government and armed movements, peaceful coexistence between tribes and the return of stability in the region and work to implement it.
