هدفت الدراسة بعنوان تقصي الصعوبات التي يواجهها طلاب المرحلة الثانوية في اللغة الانجليزية بولاية الجزيرة قام الباحث اخذ عينة من ثلاثة مدارس ثانوية للبنين والبنات لتكون عينة موضع البحث وذلك بعمل اختبار تكون من خمسين كلمة كما مبين في الفصل الثالث وعمل استبيان لاساتذة اللغة الانجليزية وقد تضمن الاستبيان عدد عشرين معلم ومعلمه يعملون با المدارس الثانوية والاساس والمعاهد العليا والجامعات متخصصين في اللغه الانجليزية وقد تم رصدد درجات الطلاب باستخدام البرنامج الاحصائي للاختبار المكون من عدد مائه طالب متوسط اعمارهم السابعة عشر والثامنة عشر.

Abstract

This study aims at investigating the difficulties face by high school students in English spelling in the state of al jazzier. The researcher takes his population from three secondary schools by makes a test for these students as to investigate their difficulties in English spelling so the researcher designs a test for one hundred students and the test contains to investigate their problematic areas in English spelling fifty words as the students study spine syllabus for six years four years in basic level and two years in basic level their age between eighteen and seventeen years old they study English as second language and their mother and language is Arabic language. Also he conducts teachers questionnaire for English in different levels basic and high English teachers who teach levels their qualifications most of them in degree of bachelor and their number are twenty teachers they are different in gender. They conduct questionnaire which contents ten statements with multi options as it mentions in chapter three. The results of teachers questionnaire comes as statements which support the positive agreements for the follow the hypothesis .The researcher shows there only four students are succeeded from the total number that refers to the weaknesses in students levels in English language spelling.
