5.1- Introduction:

5.2- Summary of the Study:

5.3- Conclusion of the Study:

Based on the results of the data analysis, the study revealed the following findings which the researcher can conclude his study with them: according to them the difficulties face the English language teachers in teaching English language in Basic Schools can be described as follow:

- Some of the teachers of English come from outside the field of education.
- Some respondents believe that large classes, the syllabus and the time create some difficulties.
- Some teachers complain about the lack of the reason for the learners to study English language.
- It is believed that some teachers do not communicate in English, which does not encourage applying the CLT.
- Some respondent teachers said that they found problems with communicative language teaching in practice.

5.4- The Recommendations for further Studies.

According to the findings of the study, the researcher recommends the following:

- 1- Syllabuses should be designed in consideration to Communicative Language Teaching techniques.
- 2- Doses of elements of fun should be injected in the syllabus.
- 3- Formulaic expression should be given much care.
- 4- The Roles of Audio and Video in enhancing teaching learning process .
- 5- The suitability of the time of English lesson.
- 6- Pupils at starting level should be familiar raised with the noise of the language.
- 7- Teachers of English language should dovetail their performance inside the classroom with their performance outside the classroom.
